Review of the film *I want you*

I want you is a 2012 Romantic Spanish film directed by Fernando González Molina. It stars Mario Casas and Clara Lago Grau as the protagonists of the story, but Maria Valverde, Nerea Camacho and Maria Salas also have an important role in it. This movie is the sequel to *Three meters above heaven*. It was distributed by Warner Bros in Spain and the film lasts 130 minutes. *I want you* was released on June 22, 2012, two years after the first.

The film tells the story of two young people who fell in love. Hache had gone to London for trying to forget Babi, his first love, and the death of his best friend Pollo. Two years after being there, he returns to Barcelona. There he met again with his brother and Katina, the ex-girlfriend of Pollo. While Hache was putting gasoil in a gas station, Ginebra tried to steal him, finally they ended up in a diner with Hache friends. By chance, Hache starts working in a television show and Ginebra went to do an audition there and she left everyone feeling breathtaking. Hache and Ginebra start falling in love but Hache can't stop thinking about Babi.



This film is very enjoyable and entertaining, it doesn't have a weak argument and it grips you because you want to know how will end. The film reaches a climax when Hache and Babi meet each other again because you don't know how will go. As the first movie, the music it's excellent because creates a mood that make the feelings of the film more intense.
